College Credit Transfer Policy



Nursing courses from another program are not transferable.

General education credits earned from an accredited institution within ten years of the program start date are considered for transfer. Anatomy and Physiology I and II must have been earned within five years of program start date. To meet the eligibility for transfer, students must provide an official transcript with evidence of course completion with a "C" or better (C minus will not be accepted). Course description and syllabi may be required to determine equivalency. Each enrolled student will receive an official transfer letter stating the courses approved for transfer. The transfer of credit will not apply to the student's overall grade point average.

Once enrolled, students are required to complete courses offered by Pennsylvania Highlands Community College during the scheduled semester following our curriculum plan. If enrolled students wish to complete course work during the summer semester between freshman and senior year, approval must be granted from the Associate Director/Director. An official transcript must be on file before the start of the Fall semester. If an official transcript is not received, then the student will be scheduled to take the general education course following the curriculum plan.
