COLLEGE CREDIT TRANSFER POLICY

Applicants who had post-secondary college education are considered on an individual basis for admission and curriculum placement. Perspective student candidates are required to submit official transcript(s) of all completed post-secondary college course work with the Conemaugh School of Radiologic Technology application for review by the Admissions Committee. Candidates may be required to provide college course description(s) for review prior to decision on eligibility of course transfers. If more information is required to determine eligibility of a course for transfer, the course syllabus must be provided for review. Course work must meet approved, established course criteria guidelines with the student achieving a minimum of a "C" grade for consideration of transfer.

Candidates not submitting official transcripts of completed course work prior to the Admissions Committee review of acceptance will not be eligible for advanced standing unless the Director of the Conemaugh School of Radiologic Technology gives special dispensation.

Candidates or students undertaking course work at other institutions during the acceptance process, or after the Admission Committee's acceptance, must request and receive approval for transferability and provide proof of enrollment for courses to be granted advanced standing upon successful completion. Prior to the August start date, each enrolled student will receive an official transfer letter stating which courses have been approved for transfer as well as the governing organization from which the credit was transferred.
