

# Intune MFA Enrollment Instructions

## Purpose

This document describes the enrollment process for Microsoft Azure Intune Multi Factor Authentication (MFA)

## Process

In order to access, the general process is:

- 1) Register via MFA setup
- 2) Setup text message communication of security code.
- 3) Setup / Login to resource/service that requires MFA.

## Set up your mobile device to use a text message as your verification method

1. From laptop or desktop computer that is not on the Conemaugh network - Browse to: <https://aka.ms/MFASetup>
2. Log in with your Conemaugh network account. Ex. username@conemaugh.org
  - a. If prompted for Work/School account or Personal account, select Work or School Account.

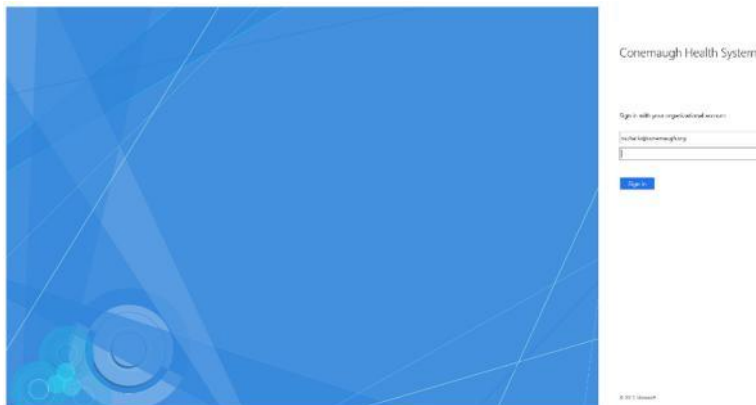

3. You will then be brought to the Conemaugh verification page, log in again with your Conemaugh network account. Ex.: username@conemaugh.org



4. On the **Additional security verification** page, select **Authentication phone** from the **How should we contact you** question, select your country or region from the drop-down list, and then type your mobile device phone number.

5. Select **Send me a code by text message** from the **Method** area, and then select **Next**.
