Carlow University – Wendy Phillips, wspillips@carlow.edu

Program is 100% online and the application is free. Receive 30 credits for your RN license. Transfer in up to 90 credits. This is an accelerated 8 weeks sessions with 5 start terms per academic year. We offer a 10% discount for corporate partners.

Program is 100% online and application fee is waived. An RN with an associate degree or diploma will be awarded 77 proficiency credits from previous educational experience. This leaves 45 credit hours remaining – and you can transfer in additional qualifying credits. The RN-BSN option is 122 credits. Courses are completed according to your schedule. Offers a 15% tuition reduction. All associate degree in nursing (ADN) and diploma program students are now eligible for a new dual enrollment program. Eligible students receive **two tuition-free**, fully online college courses toward the pursuit of a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree



Drexel University – Jeffrey Asay, jpa64@drexel.edu

Obtain BSN in as little as 12 months. Drexel operates on a quarter system and will allow transfer up to 135 of the required 180 quarter credits. Offers a 25% tuition savings to CSON graduates.

Awards a minimum of 84 credits and a maximum of 90 credits to Conemaugh School of Nursing students; Requires an additional 9-11 courses to complete the online Bachelors program, and can be obtained in 12-14 months. Offers graduates up to 25% tuition scholarship for Bachelor of Science in Nursing program.

A Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree completion program requiring 120 credits. CSON students are guaranteed 40 transfer credits based on their current nursing coursework. Any college-level credits they have earned through UPJ, PHCC, etc. may be added to that number, based on program requirements. Many CSON students who enroll at Mount Aloysius start with 50-60 transfer credits. Mount Aloysius College can accept up to 90 applicable transfer credits into our B.S.N. program. The length of the program is dependent on an individualized plan, which can be discussed with your academic advisor upon enrollment. We offer a 25% discount for working nurses and a merit scholarship of up to \$10,000 per academic year, based on CSON GPA.
