A graduate of the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry in New York, Dr. Spencer completed her Family Practice Residency at Conemaugh Memorial Medical Center where she served as chief resident. Upon graduation, she was hired as a faculty member and promoted to Program Director in 2002. Her professional areas of interest include breastfeeding and primary HIV care.

On a personal level, Dr. Spencer was born in New York and moved to Johnstown for her residency training. She is married with six children; she and her husband have also been foster parents for years. In her free time, she enjoys traveling, bicycling, and playing tennis.
