2023-2024 School of Radiologic Technology Cost of Attendance

The cost of attendance (COA) is the **estimate** of educational expenses to attend school. **The actual expenses will vary.** The COA includes the estimate of tuition and fees, cost of living expenses (food and housing), cost of books, supplies, transportation, loan fees, and miscellaneous personal expenses. The COA is used to help determine what financial aid a student may be eligible to receive. The student's total financial aid, including scholarships, grants, federal loans, private loans, etc., cannot exceed their COA. Below is the COA for the 2023-2024 academic year. The COA is updated on an annual basis.
