- I. **85% or 11 of 13** radiologic technology students enrolled in this program completed the program and graduated in **2022**.
- II. Graduate surveys were mailed to the most recent graduates in Spring of 2022 for Class of 2021 (Graduate Survey). Input from this survey is used to update the school's employment data. 1 of 9 surveys were returned. 100% of the surveys that were returned said that they would recommend Conemaugh's School of Radiologic Technology educational program. The program is looking to improve their methods.
- III. 5 year-average credentialing examination pass rate 80% (2018 2022)
 5 year-average job placement rate 100% (2018 2022)
 (Graduates employed after graduation that were actively seeking employment.)
- IV. In our locality, the starting hourly wage for graduated technologists in this field is between \$20.00 \$24.00. Nationally, the average wage was around \$31.88.
- V. All graduates of the school are eligible to take the National Registry Examination given by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists. All individuals must pass this examination in order to perform radiologic procedures on a routine basis as a registered radiographer.
- VI. The program does meet the requirements established for state licensure within the state of Pennsylvania.
