

Articulation Agreements

Various college and university nursing programs provide nursing advancement opportunities for nursing graduates toward attaining a baccalaureate degree in nursing (BSN) and/or Master's degree in Nursing (MSN). Recognition of Conemaugh nursing courses or successful achievement on challenge exams affords the Conemaugh graduate additional college credits for advanced placement in RN-BSN or RN-MSN programs. Conemaugh School of Nursing has partnerships and articulation agreements with colleges and universities which transfer a specific number of college credits and/or offer substantial discounts toward BSN, MSN and DNP programs. Articulation agreements include: Carlow University, Chamberlain University and Grand Canyon University. Dual Admission agreements include Mount Aloysius College. Partnerships include: Chamberlain College of Nursing and Drexel University. Cooperative agreements include Pennsylvania Highlands Community College.
