4. Red, firm, warm, and/or tender areas of the breast
5. Breast refusal
6. Baby losing weight or having a slow weight gain
7. Feeding difficulties

A lactation specialist is available to evaluate your concerns and determine it is necessary for you to be seen.

Outpatient visits are by appointment only and only with a doctor's order.

Our hours are 7:00 am- 3:00 pm Monday through Saturday. We are closed Sundays along with holidays.
